APPLY

I want to commence a traineeship at a Sunrise Christian School (SCS) ELC.

- Apply for an Early Childhood Educator role at a SCS ELC
- Attend a job interview
- Accept an offer of employment
- Work with my school VET Coordinator to arrange an Apprenticeship Network Provider (e.g MAS National <https://masnational.com.au/>)
- Work with my school VET Coordinator to apply to study a Cert III in Early Childhood Education (RTO Code 40201)

PREPARE

I have been accepted to commence a traineeship at a Sunrise Christian School ELC. How do I prepare myself?

- Apply for an Employment based Working With Children Check
- Undertake Reporting Risks of Harm and Abuse Training
- Apply for a Tax File Number
- Sign up to a Superannuation Fund
- Work with my school VET Coordinator to arrange my school timetable to include my work days at ELC
- Work with my school VET Coordinator to submit a "School Referral to VET" form
- Work with my school VET Coordinator to submit a Form 1285

COMMENCE TRAINEESHIP

Expectations while I work and study towards my Cert III in Early Childhood Education.

- Undergo onboarding and induction at SCS ELC
- Attain work uniform (provided)
- Gain wages paid in accordance with Sunrise Christian School ELCs Enterprise Agreement
- Student to undertake all assignments as specified by Cert III training provider
- Be provided with support, mentorship and professional development
- Be provided with paid study time onsite
